



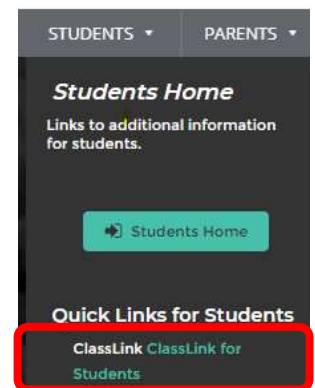
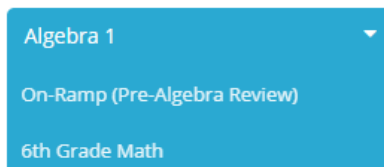
Dear Parents and Guardians,

Congratulations! Next year, your child will be taking High School Algebra 1. Algebra 1 includes an End Of Course Exam that students are required to pass to satisfy one of the high school graduation requirements. To help prepare your child for the rigors of Algebra 1, your child can log onto Math Nation through ClassLink and use the On-Ramp to Algebra 1. The On-Ramp to Algebra 1 is an adaptive learning tool that provides an individualized learning path for your child. When the student first logs into On-Ramp they begin by taking the “Start-Up” quiz. After the quiz, the students will then be placed on their individualized learn pathways. Even though the On-Ramp states that it is a Pre-Algebra review, there are also other skills that are addressed within these pathways.

- 1) To access the Math Nation On-Ramp, go to polkschools.com and under the **Students** tab select **ClassLink for Students**.
- 2) Next, log into ClassLink and then click on the Algebra/Math Nation icon:



- 3) This will take students into their student area. On the left side, they will need to click on the drop down menu and choose On-Ramp (Pre-Algebra Review)



As soon as they enter the On-Ramp, they will be prompted to begin the adaptive quiz. After the quiz, students will then know what skills they need to review to help them prepare for Algebra 1.
